Representative Clifford Lindberg brings suit in Burleigh County.

Alleges law is unconstitutional


Does business with the State as a general contractor





Vote On \$10,000 Limit Is 3-2 For Constitutionality

Lindberg v. Benson





"No individual has a legal right to be selected as a contractor for the state."

One argument - "Too far fetched to warrant serious consideration."

All or Nothing - see South Dakota





 - Safeguard in Section 43 of the North Dakota Constitution


